Dear Families,

As promised, this letter serves to provide you with greater details around the process for picking up report cards next week on **June 23 from 8am-12pm**. There will not be scheduled time slots as there was with the pick-up of student belongings but, the process will be a similar drive-thru style.

Each family may designate one representative to attend the school for the purpose of report card pick-up. That person must use the [COVID-19 Self-Assessment](#) just prior to attending and must pass the assessment. Although the preference will be for families to pick-up by vehicle, walkers will be permitted. As we did with the belongings pick-up, vehicles will pull up to the stopping area, marked by pylons. The family designate will get out of their vehicle (or be called upon from the “walkers” line) and will obtain the report card(s) which will be set out on a table beside the vehicle. Please wait for staff direction.

At all times, physical distancing measures will be adhered to. Once the report card is picked up, a prompt departure is expected. There cannot be any congregating or visiting on school property unfortunately. Should you not be able to attend during this time, the report card(s) will be mailed to your home.

As our year ends, I'd like to acknowledge that our distant learning experiences could never replace the in-school face-to-face learning experiences. Keeping safe and well required everyone to stay home and keep distant. This is certainly not a natural way of being and our COVID days continue to have a tremendous impact on so many people in our dear community. My daily prayers continue to be steady and true, for the protection and wellness of staff, students, and St. Theresa families throughout this school year and into the summer months.
